- Every student brings 1 box of tissues.

Every student needs basic supplies for every class:

Required Supplies

- Class dividers for binder (5)
- 3 subject spiral notebook
- A pencil pouch for notebook

- Dell Laptop- bring to class every day

- Highlighter
- Hand held pencil sharpener that can catch shavings

Optional Supplies, but Highly Recommended:

- Any kind of device to save computer work (flash drive, zip drive, etc.)- This can really come in handy for ensuring that you do not lose work on your computer; however, remember that this supply is completely optional!
- Plastic sheet protectors for loose-leaf papers
