

**2019-2020 Sixth Grade School Supply

Be sure to bring these supplies with you to **Hawk Hill Camp on August 22nd**. Your homeroom teacher will help you organize your locker and binders. If you are unable to attend, please bring your supplies the first day of school.

- (1) pencil pouch
- (20) pencils
- (1) red pen
- (1) package of glue sticks
- (4) black or blue pens
- (1) box colored pencils (12/box)
- (1) package of eraser caps
- (8) dry eraser markers (low odor)
- (2) three-subject plastic cover spiral notebook, wide-ruled (Mead or 5 star) for Math and Reading
- (1) composition book (only for Gifted Enrichment)
- (2) 3-ring binder (1" – 1 ½") for History and Science (no zipper binders)
- (12) dividers with tabs - letter size
- (2) 100/pack index cards - 3 x 5 inch, ruled (History and Gift Enrichment)
- (1) pack of loose-leaf notebook paper
- (1) personal pencil sharpener
- (1) plastic folder with pocket or accordion style (to hold homework, elective assignments and extra notebook paper)
- (1) facial tissue, large box
- (1) Gallon size Ziploc bags – **Girls**
- (1) Sandwich size Ziploc bags – **Boys**
- (1) inexpensive headphones with name on it
- (1) planner to record homework (optional)
- (1) backpack - locker size is 10 ½ x 12 inch; rolling backpacks do NOT fit in lockers.
